Addition of agenda item from College of Education and Human Sciences on a one-time only assessment fee of \$125 for all COEHS students in lieu of purchasing individual subscriptions to the bookstore. Directly billing student accounts will allow students to apply financial aid toward this necessary subscription and that the COEHS has the capacity to collect required data for accreditation purposes. Bill will be initiated when a student enrolls in a course with one of the following prefixes: ECE, EED, ED or EEX.

Revision to Section 1.6 of the Faculty Handbook – Curriculum Committee

### 1.6 CURRICULUM COMMITTEE

The Curriculum Committee initiates, reviews, and recommends curricular change in courses and programs at the university level; communicates its deliberations and findings to the President and after discussion with the President, to the university community reports to the President through the Vice President for Academic Affairs and Provost. Curriculum Committee is composed of five faculty from the College of Arts and Sciences, recommended by the Faculty Senate; three faculty from the College of Business, recommended by the Faculty Senate; three faculty from the College of Education and Human Sciences, recommended by the Faculty Senate; one faculty from the College of Nursing, recommended by the Faculty Senate; and one student recommended by the Student Government Association. The Vice President for Academic Affairs and Provost or designee, all deans, and the Registrar are voting members of this committee.

Dr. Rock moved approval and Dr. Kinney seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

Consideration of the request from the College of Nursing Online to delete NU 501, Advanced Nursing Research (3), from RN to MSN online option; Add NU 508, Advanced Health Assessment (3), to RN to MSN online option; and revision of course title and description for NU 416R, Role/Theory Online to NU 416R, Quality in Prof Nursing.

Dr. Rock moved approval and Dr. Roden seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

Consideration of the requests from the Department of Psychology: Revised credit hours and course description for PY 495; Revised course title and course description: PY 499; Proposed new courses: PY 497 and PY 498.

Dr. Kinney moved approval and Dr. Infanger seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

Information item from the Department of History and Political Science: HI 410 and HI 510, American Architecture to HI 416/516. These courses were approved as 410/510 and that number was previously used. New Agenda item: Consideration of the request from the College of Education and Human Sciences to implement a one-time only assessment fee in association with all courses offered in the COEHS, EED, ED and EEX as well as designated content methods courses for secondary and postsecondary education majors and other COEHS courses as appropriate (i.e. HES or HPER).

Dr. Lindley moved approval and Dr. Rock seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.
