

UNIVERSITY OF NORTH ALABAMA STUDENT IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

The University of North Alabama (UNA) requires that first-time entering domestic and international students, and visiting international scholars, provide proof of immunization against certain diseases.

The following immunizations and screenings are **required**: Tuberculosis (TB) screening, MMR, Varicella, Meningococcal, Tdap, and a Medical J.8 Tw 0.521 (an)e3J0.7edede 0 Th0.521 (an)e3J003

MMR: Measles, Mumps, Rubella- Students born after 1956- 2 doses of MMR at least 28 days apart after 12 months of age OR a copy of a lab report showing proof of immunity from Measles (Rubeola), Mumps, and Rubella can be submitted.

VARICELLA(Chickenpox/Shingles) – Students born after 1979 – 2 doses of Varicella vaccine at least 28 days apart OR healthcare provider documented history with the date of the disease OR a copy of a lab report showing proof of a positive Varicella IgG antibody.

MENINGOCOCCAL Meningitis (A, C, W, Y) - Students age 21 and younger –

tuberculosis testing may be required based on information received from the screening questions. A student with a positive TB screening test cannot attend class until follow-up testing determines there is no active Tuberculosis disease. All TB testing must be performed in the United States.

MEDICAL HISTORY FORM – All students must complete the Medical History Form. This form should be updated annually.
