1) UNAE-mail

- x Check UNAE-mail several times per week to avoid missing important information.

2) Advisor(s)

- x Education advisor will be assigned upon completion of 45 credit hours. This is the primary advisor.
- x Education majors (6-12, P-12 ONLY) should visit the department of teaching field for assignment of a content advisor.

5) GPA Requirements for Undergraduate Admittance to TEP

- x Undergraduate GPA requirements for the Teacher Education Program are:
2.75 Institutional, 2.50 Overall, 3.0 Professional Studies and 2.75 Teaching Field

- x All courses must be completed prior to internship. Plan accordingly paying special attention to prerequisites.
- x Keep track of when classes are offered so graduation is not delayed.
- x It is the student's responsibility to read the catalog, create ~~the~~ a plan, and register for the appropriate classes.
- x Updated 4-year plans should be brought to all advisement sessions.
